

## **SPORT MIGRANT INTEGRATION PLATFORM**

The Council of Europe's Enlarged Partial Agreement on Sport (EPAS) organised in June 2016 a Conference on the theme of the integration of newly-arrived migrants via sport. The outcomes of this conference saw calls for sport integration networks to have greater coordination, and for more information to be available regarding the promising practices of such projects.

EPAS will therefore launch in Spring 2017 a living network of integration projects, where projects are presented, information shared, and a forum is provided to allow those who are working in sport and integration to have a functioning knowledge-exchange available to them.
